## THE CHALLENGE

Inventory systems are only as reliable as the people managing them. When staffing is inconsistent or roles are not clearly defined, accuracy begins to break down. Materials may appear available in the system but are not accessible on the floor, forcing teams into reactive decisions. As pressure builds, operations shift toward expediting, workarounds, and short-term fixes instead of controlled, predictable flow. Without dedicated ownership of stock control, even strong systems fail to deliver reliable results.

When stock control roles are understaffed or treated as secondary administrative work, small gaps begin to form. Over time, those gaps lead to material shortages, excess inventory, and constant corrections that disrupt operations. Inventory accuracy does not start in the system, it starts with the people behind it.
