THE CHALLENGE

Aisle and Dock Congestion

Inexperienced operators slow down picking, loading, and receiving when throughput depends on smooth flow.

Line Stoppages

Missed material moves leave production lines without the components or raw materials needed to keep running.

Product and Rack Damage

Rushed or undertrained operators increase damage rates that add cost and create safety exposure throughout the facility.

Higher Incident Rates

Equipment incidents involving pedestrians, infrastructure, or product are more likely when operators lack proper screening and orientation.
