THE CHALLENGE

THE REAL IMPACT

Unauthorized Equipment Operation

Operators placed on truck types they were not trained and evaluated for create compliance violations before a shift begins.

Incident and Injury Exposure

Undertrained operators working around pedestrians, racks, and dock equipment increase the likelihood of preventable incidents.

Audit and Documentation Risk

Incomplete or inconsistent training records leave facilities exposed when inspections or incident investigations occur.

Overtime and Coverage Strain

A small pool of certified operators stretched across all shifts and equipment types creates fatigue risk.
