THE CHALLENGE

Falls remain the leading cause of serious injuries and fatalities on construction job sites because the rules depend on people to follow them. Harnesses not tied off, guardrails removed for convenience, and improvised access at height are crew behaviors, not equipment failures. Training and policies matter, but they only work when the tradespeople on site take fall protection seriously before the foreman says a word.

Staffing decisions directly shape that reality. High turnover, rushed onboarding, and crews assembled without screening for safety habits put projects at risk every time work moves to elevation.

THE REAL IMPACT

When crews working at elevation are staffed without attention to safety habits and fall protection, the consequences extend well beyond the incident itself.

Work Stoppages and OSHA Citations

A single fall protection violation can trigger an inspection, a stop-work order, and citations.

Schedule Disruption

Investigations, retraining, and crew replacements consume time that projects cannot afford to lose.

Crew Culture Breakdown

Cutting corners on fall protection creates permission for others to do the same, eroding the safety standard across the whole site.

Owner and Contract Exposure

Incidents at height generate liability and damage standing with project owners and general contractors.
