THE CHALLENGE

Fleet maintenance plans only work when the right people are ready when the vessel hits the yard. Shipyards, dry-docks, ports, and repair facilities depend on skilled tradespeople who can support structural, piping, mechanical, electrical, coating, and service work without slowing critical maintenance windows.

Fleet maintenance does not leave much room for labor gaps. Schedule Delays

Thin or inconsistent crews can stretch repair windows and delay return-to-service timelines.

Work Scope Pressure

Deferred tasks can roll into the next docking when teams cannot keep pace with planned work.

Trade Coordination Gaps

Structural, piping, mechanical, electrical, and coating work can lose sequence without experienced support.

Crew Strain

Core teams carry heavier oversight demands when workers are not shipyard-ready.
