THE CHALLENGE

Megaproject schedules depend on more than materials, drawings, and equipment. They depend on having the right skilled trades in place when critical path work is ready to move. When one trade is thinly staffed, constantly rebuilding crews, or relying too heavily on overtime, the impact can move across the entire project.

Critical scopes such as electrical, mechanical, structural, piping, and millwright work often determine whether major milestones stay on track or begin to slip. Even when plans are complete and materials are available, inconsistent labor coverage can create missed handoffs, rework, delays, and compressed downstream phases.

THE REAL IMPACT

Skilled trades staffing gaps do not stay isolated. They can affect the entire project schedule:

Milestone Delays

Understaffed trades can slow or stop critical path activities.

Missed Handoffs

When crews are not ready at the right time, downstream teams lose momentum.

Increased Rework

Unstable or inexperienced crews may create quality issues that require correction.

Compressed Schedules

Delays in one phase often create pressure on later phases, increasing risk and cost.
