THE CHALLENGE

Dry-dock dates are fixed. Whether shipyards and operators have the people to hit them is not. Every docking window compresses steel repairs, piping and mechanical work, electrical jobs, coatings, tank work, and support tasks into a few intense weeks. Once the vessel is on the blocks, there is little room to start chasing labor or rebuilding crews.

If workforce planning starts too late, teams may be forced to scramble for welders, fitters, electricians, blasters, painters, firewatch, tank watch, and support personnel while critical repair scopes are already underway. The strongest dry-dock strategies account for trade-specific headcount, peak-week demand, core crew capacity, and supplemental labor needs before the vessel arrives.

THE REAL IMPACT

Late labor planning doesn't just slow work down, it creates dry-dock risk:

Schedule Pressure

Unfilled roles can slow steel repairs, piping, electrical, coatings, and mechanical scopes during peak weeks.

Deferred Work

When crews are short, lower-priority tasks may be pushed out of the docking window or rolled into a future service period.

Cost Escalation

Last-minute labor gaps can lead to overtime pressure, extended stays, and avoidable project delays.

Crew Strain

Core yard teams carry heavier workloads when supplemental crews are not planned and aligned early.

Dry-dock performance depends on workforce readiness. Docking windows are short, coordinated, and highly dependent on trade availability. When labor planning is treated as an afterthought, shipyards and operators may lose valuable time trying to fill roles instead of executing the repair plan.
